## Survey Follow Up Email Template

When you send a survey you're asking the customer for their feedback and engaging in a 2-way conversation. Regardless if they respond or not, the ball is in your court to follow up. Failing to continue the conversation invites disappointment and may have a negative impact on response rate in the future.
